

# Ring Sizer - WeddingRings.net

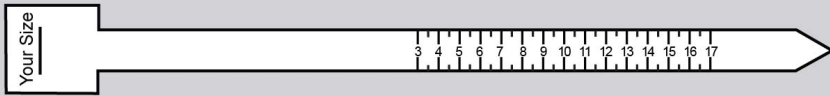
The most accurate way to determine your ring size is to visit your local jeweler and allow them to measure your ring size. When this option is not available, **print this PDF at 100%** and follow the instructions below.

## String, Thread or Ribbon

- ◆ Print this document.
- ◆ Cut a piece of string, thread or ribbon.
- ◆ Wrap it around your ring finger and note where 2 points of the string touch.
- ◆ Make sure that the string is not too tight.
- ◆ Always try this once in the morning as well as late at night.
- ◆ Place the string on one of the circles at left or below and note your size.

## Paper Ring Sizer

- ◆ Print this document.
- ◆ Carefully cut out the paper ring sizer below.
- ◆ Make a small slit in the line below the text that reads "Your Size".
- ◆ Slip the pointed end through the slit you created.
- ◆ Place your ring finger inside of the paper and gently pull the end of the sizer.
- ◆ Note the number that appears outside of the "Your Size" text.
- ◆ Always try this once in the morning as well as late at night.



## Use Your Own Ring

- ◆ Print this document.
- ◆ Take a ring that fits your ring finger.
- ◆ Hold the ring up against the circles on the right or bottom of this page.
- ◆ If the ring does not match exactly, it may be a quarter size or become bent.
- ◆ If your ring is a quarter size or doesn't match, please call us for our advice.
